Description of Duties:

This is a grant funded position. -Provide evidence-based individual and group counseling services to support clients' partners', families' mental health, behavioral health, and wellness goals. -Conduct comprehensive psychosocial, behavioral health, and social determinants of health assessments using validated screening tools to identify client needs and inform care planning. -Develop individualized care plans, coordinate referrals, and help connect clients to medical, behavioral health, and supportive services, including follow-up to confirm successful linkage and appointment attendance. -Collaborate with interdisciplinary team members and community partners to deliver integrated, client centered care and improve health outcomes. - Document all patient activities in the electronic medical record and on required data forms and in tracking logs in a timely manner; complete required reporting activities. -Provide crisis intervention and serve as mental health lead in the STAR Health Center. -Participate in quality improvement initiatives and STAR Program outreach and education efforts; Assist with additional duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

REQUIRED: Master's degree in social work and NYS license required (LCSW, LMSW); 1-2 years' post-license experience conducting screening, assessments, individual and group counseling using evidence-based interventions. Effective written, verbal, organizational, and interpersonal skills. Must have the ability to work independently and as part of a multidisciplinary team. Proficient in computer use, including typing and using Excel, PowerPoint, and Word. PREFERRED: Experience providing substance use counseling using harm reduction approach. Experience in HIV prevention and treatment. Experience working with LGBTQIA+, Black, Latinx, and/or Immigrant populations; bilingual English/Haitian Creole or English/Spanish. Experience documenting in electronic medical record.
